Rev. Michael Zeigler has accepted a call to serve as the next Lutheran Hour speaker, beginning our next era of Gospel proclamation together. His first broadcast will occur on Reformation Sunday, October 28th. As a part of our ministry team, he will also be a key player in other ministry efforts.

The program broadcasts on more than 1,800 radio stations (locally on WCCO AM, Sundays at 6:05am). It also airs for military personnel on the American Forces Network. And, as a current part-time officer of the Air Force Reserve, Rev. Zeigler brings a unique understanding of the importance of this broadcast venue."
